

### WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.



Practise counting up to 20. This can be done through playing hide and seek, singing number songs, chanting, board games etc.

Practise recognising amounts up to five or up to ten by playing these games. This can be done by reading a dice when playing board games, playing with cards, identifying how many food items on the plate etc.


Write out the digits 0 - 20. Use your number formation sheet to help you!



Write 0-20 on some building bricks and see if you can put the numbers in the correct order to build the tower.

### WEEKLY LITERACY TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Identify all of the rhyming words that are used in the story. Can you think of other words that rhyme with these?



Listen to the story 'Tiddler' lots of times and encourage children to join in repeated words and phrases

Use a cardboard tube to create a 3d fish.

Create some Lollipop Stick characters to help retell the story
