Divide numbers (2d/1d and 3d/1d) with and without remainders

Multiply numbers together (2dx1d, 3dx1d)

WEEKLY READING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

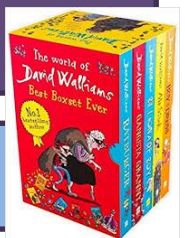
Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
