WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Working on Times Table Rockstars - your child will have an individual login to access this

Add and subtract amounts up to 4 digits. For example, $2345 + 3271$ or $9230 - 2832$. You could make this fun and into a game by rolling the dice to create the numbers, solve the calculation and see whose answer is the highest to win.

Practise multiplying 3digit numbers by 1 digit numbers. For example, $567 \times 8 = 4536$. Then check your calculations by doing the inverse for example, $4536 \div 8 = 567$

Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.

Practise telling the time. Set your day out draw clocks to show the time you are doing the activity and the length of time you are doing it for.

WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Write a character description of your favourite film character. Can someone in your family guess who it is?

Write a recount of your day. This could be used in history one day to show what happened during this period.

Practise 10 year 3/4 common exception words (these can be found online).

Write a recipe (including the method) for a family tea.

Write a letter to a member of your family that does not live in your house.

WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Can you make your very own volcano? Be creative in the materials you choose.

Make an information poster about Earth's natural disasters for a member of your family.

Does gas weigh anything? Can you create an experiment to answer this question (google may help with ideas).

Make your own obstacle course for the family.

WEEKLY READING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.

Read a book on Oxford Owl and discuss what you liked about it.

Share a story with your family. This could be a chapter book where you read and discuss a chapter a day.

Write a book review to share with other children on Twitter.

Find five new words, which you don't know the meaning of, and find their meaning then teach your family these new words.
