## YEAR 5 – WEEK 1

### WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Working on Times Table Rockstars - your child will have an individual login to access this

Get a piece of paper and ask your child to show everything they know about fractions. Can they show fractions of shapes in different ways?

Get your child to work on their reasoning and problem solving by practising past SATs questions that are broken down into topic areas and have videos linked to them that can be watched if needed.

Practise arithmetic skills. Adding and subtracting 3 and 4 digit numbers.

Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.



### WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Practise spelling and using the words from the Y5 and Y6 National Curriculum spellings

Write a character description of a character in your favourite book or film. Include information about personality, behaviour and appearance.

Try to write the events of the week (either your own or the news) in the form of the front page of a newspaper. Try to give each story a headline.

Write a poem about a member of your family or a pet. Don't forget to use similes, metaphors and figurative language

Read a chapter of a book and write a summary to share with someone in your family

### WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Find out which climate zones or biomes there are in USA and Canada

Find 10 facts about the United States of America and 10 facts about Canada.

Choose one biome eg savannah and write a factfile including: climate, plants and animals you might expect to find there.

Find the names of the countries in North America and draw the flags of each one.

Draw or paint a picture in the style of John Singer Sargent or Georgia O'Keefe

### WEEKLY READING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Think about your favourite story. Draw a comic strip of the story or apart of the story.

Read a chapter of a book and write 5 questions which you could ask a fellow reader

Sign up to Oxford Owl and read the first chapter of Dragon Tales. Draw your own Dragon surrounded by expanded noun phrases describing its features and special powers

Share a book with someone in your family

Sit back, relax and read for 20 minutes
