WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Working on Times Table Rockstars - your child will have an individual login to access this

Have a go at one of these challenges:

First to 100. You will need a deck of playing cards and a sheet of paper. Shuffle a pack of cards and place face down. Each player takes one card and turns it over in front of them. Record the number of the card (Ace is 1, pictures are 10). Take it in turns at adding the number on the card until the first person reaches 100. They are the winner.

Practise telling the time to the nearest minute.

WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Research one of the creatures in the story and write a report about it. What does it eat? How does it move? How is it adapted to help it live underwater?
