WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Working on Times Table Rockstars - your child will have an individual login to access this

Practise telling the time using analogue and digital clocks. Convert times am and pm to 24 hr clock. Explore timetables and work out the times of journeys.

Get your child to work on their reasoning and problem solving by practising past SATs questions that are broken down into topic areas and have videos linked to them that can be watched if needed.

Practise arithmetic skills. This week multiply and divide.

Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.



WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Practise to spell and use 10 words from the Y5 and Y6 National Curriculum spellings

Do some research about a sea creature. Write a report about it. Think about: appearance, habitat, food and nutrition, conservation

Find some rivers in North America on a map. Find out about the stages of a river, from the source to the sea.
