6 8 12 17 21 25


Can you count in 2s, 5s and 10s?


Keep up reading and writing numbers to 100! Make sure than none of your numbers are facing the wrong way!

Choose one of the animals from the story. How many sentences can you write to describe the animal.


Can you make these animal words plural? Plural means more than one so cow becomes cows.




WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)
