

### WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Listen to the story on YouTube. Can you have a go at writing part of the story word for word to test your punctuation and spellings?

Write a fact file on a tiger. Where does it live? What does it eat? Does anything eat tigers? Any other facts.

Write a letter of invitation to a different animal, persuading them to come to your house for tea.

Create a similar style story but in a different habitat with different animals.

Make up a similar story to the tiger that came to tea. Who came to tea? What would happen? Would dad believe you when he got home?

### WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Find out about tigers. Where do they live? What do they eat? Create a report with the information you have found.

Draw a tiger. Concentrate on the patterns on their fur.

Use 2Paint on Purple Mash to create a label for a tin of tiger food.

If you could have anyone come to tea, who would it be and why? What would you ask them? Write a set of questions and tag the person on twitter to try and get some answers.
