WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)


Use a measuring jug to help with cooking.

Practise telling the time. Set your day out draw clocks to show the time you are doing the activity and the length of time you are doing it for.

Can you create a fraction wall with a whole, halves, thirds, quarters, fifths, sixths, sevenths, eighths, ninths and tenths?



WEEKLY WRITING TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Write a letter of appreciation to Tom Moore, the man who has raised over £12 million for the NHS.

Write an email to a friend/family member.

Write a setting description for a place, where you have been on a walk.

Practise another 10 year 3/4 common exception words (these can be found online).

Write a set of instructions for an activity/game you have played.

WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Draw a map of your local area and include a key (e.g. squares are houses, triangles are shoppes).

Draw/paint a scenic picture from one of your outings.

How many different signs of spring can you find? How do you know these are signs? Can you describe the changes, which have happened?

Have a picnic for the Queen's birthday.

Research the Queen and find out all about her life. Can you write a fact file?

Write a book review.

Read a story to a member of your family.

Find five new words, which you don't know the meaning of, and find their meaning then teach your family these new words.

Read a poem and share with a family member.
