

### WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.



Practise saying numbers in order by learning the number song 'One Potato, Two Potato'



Can you count how many vegetables Oliver tried in the story? How many servings of each vegetable did he have?

Can you take 3 or 4 food items from your cupboard and order them from lightest to heaviest?




If Oliver's Grandad grew 7 carrots and Oliver ate 3 of them, how many are left? Can you write it as a number sentence?



### WEEKLY LITERACY TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Listen to the story 'Oliver's Vegetables' on YouTube. Discuss what happens in the story with a grown



Can you make a list of all the vegetables in the story? Now can you think of a word to describe each vegetable?



Discuss why it is so important to eat healthy. Now can you make a healthy eating poster.

Can you research one vegetable from the story and write a sentence about it with some interesting facts!
