### WEEKLY MATHS TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Working on Numbots - your child will have an individual login to access this.

Add 7 to each of these numbers...

2 9 11 25 20 4

There's 21 different ways to make the number 20. Can you find them all? We'll start you off...  $0 + 20 = 20$ ,  $1 + 19 = 20$ ...

Practising doubling and halving numbers from 1 – 20. Do you notice a pattern? Use this game to help you.

### WEEKLY LITERACY TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Listen to Miss Cooper read "There's a tiger in the garden".

Discuss: Did the story end how you thought it would? Did any parts surprise you?

Can you make up your own story about a wild animal living in your garden? This could be a real animal or a made up mythical creature!

Write a garden setting description.

Either sit in your own garden to do this or use the illustrations from the book for inspiration. Remember to use lots of adjectives to describe what you can see.

E.g. tall leafy trees, fluffy white clouds, green spiky grass

How do you think Nora felt when we found all of the different animals and creatures? How many words can you think of? Maybe use a thesaurus to help you (there's some really great online ones). 😊 😞

### WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)



Watch outside of your window. What animals can you see? Make a list. Is there an animal you see more often?

Keep your eyes peeled for magpies, cats, squirrels etc.

The illustrations in the book are beautiful! Can you create your own beautiful garden illustration? You could use paints, chalk, pastels or pencil crayons.

Create your own shoebox garden and fill it with your favourite animals. You could even collect leaves, twigs, stones, and grass for this on a local walk.



**Keep active:** can you create your own obstacle course in your house or garden? You could use pillows, rope, stepping stones, skipping ropes or anything you have handy! Can you complete the obstacle course quicker than your grown ups?
