Complete the activity



You find a tiny dragon and decide you are going to keep it. It is magic and it can grow so you can ride on it. Where do you go? What adventures do you have? Write your story.

Write a non-chronological report about your dragon. Think about your paragraph headings, eg. Appearance, habitat, food and diet, special powers etc. Don't forget to use expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials.

You decide that you are going to sell your dragon. Can you write to persuade someone to buy it?

Draw your own dragon or find a picture and write a detailed description of it. Think carefully about the vocabulary choices you make.

### WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

The largest lake in South America is Lake Titicaca. Can you find out some facts about it? How could you persuade people to visit it?

Many people travel to Machu Picchu in Peru. Find out why it is important and why people might want to visit it.

Ask if you can help prepare a meal or do some baking where you have to follow a recipe. Find out the cost of the ingredients.



A lot of South American art work is very highly patterned and brightly coloured. Can you create a South American inspired pattern?
