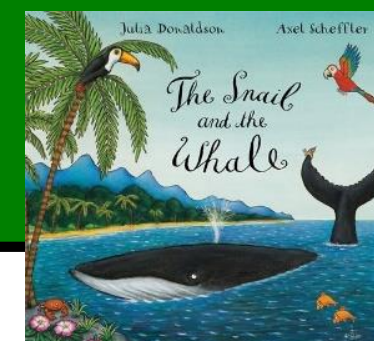

EXPLORE IT:
Read the

ILLUSTRATE IT: Look at the fruits and vegetables you have in your home. Can you draw your favourite fruit or vegetable for someone else to see?

CREATE IT: Using the ideas, you have thought about, design your own dream garden

TALK ABOUT IT: What words or phrases might be used to describe the place where Pattan lives?

IMAGINE IT: What do plants need to survive and grow?

WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday: Design a new shell for the snail.

Tuesday: Use purple mash to create a whale.

Wednesday: Create some characters to help retell the story e.g. using lollipop sticks.

Thursday: Can you find any snails or snail trails in your garden?
Research how a snail moves.

WEEKLY ENGLISH TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday - Write about how you would feel at each place the snail visited.

Tuesday - Write a thank you letter from the snail.

Wednesday - Find the messages the snail wrote in the book and write them in your best handwriting. Create your own message you would like to write.

Thursday - There are lots of adjectives used in this story. Find and list them.

Friday - Design and write an invitation to all the snails asking them to join you on a trip with the whale.
