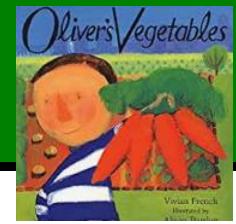

Topic

Can you write a character profile for one of the characters?

Thursday – Imagine it
Re-read extract and imagine you have just joined this class.
Can you write a diary entry about your first day?

Create a list of ways to make someone feel welcome when they start a new school.
