Monday – Read Somebody Swallowed Stanley (or watch on you tube). What is the meaning behind this story? Find out about the author

Tuesday – What is the impact of plastic in our oceans? Research and create a poster about reducing plastic pollution.

Wednesday – Discuss the pros and cons of using plastic. Consider the properties it has as a material. What alternatives could be used? Write a report. How many uses can you find for a plastic bag/ bottle?

Thursday – Plastic is waterproof and could be used to make the roof for a hut. What other materials could be used to create a waterproof roof.

Friday – Sea turtles are an endangered species. How can we protect them? Create a fact file or poster.

THE POWER OF READING – Goodnight Mister Tom

Monday – Explore it

Read the extract without looking at the title of the book. Summarise what is happening. How does the extract make you feel? Does it remind you of anything? What parts stick in your mind? When do you think the book is set?

Tuesday – Illustrate it

What impression do you get of each character? Find words and phrases that help you to imagine what they are like. Draw a sketch of William from Tom's perspective. Would he look confident or shy? Think about his body language.

Wednesday – Talk about it

Look at the front cover of the book. What details do you notice that reinforce the impression you have after reading the extract? How do you think the relationship between Mr Tom and William will develop?

Thursday – Imagine it

Imagine you were a child like William during WW2. How would you have felt as you took the train to somewhere you had never been before? What would you have told your new family about yourself? What would have helped you feel more at home?

Friday – Create it

Imagine you are going away somewhere and can only take 5 items with you that are special. What would you take and why is each one so special to you?
