## WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday: Look at the objects you usually throw away in your house. Sort these into different materials like paper, plastic, tin, glass etc.

Tuesday: Look at the bins at your house. Do you know what they're for? Find out which recycling items goes in each bin.

Wednesday: Create your own amazing illustration or model of Earth.

Thursday: Create your own toy out of recycled materials you have around your home.

Friday:  
Make your own fat balls/other bird feeder to help feed the birds like in our book. Watch over the weekend to see if any birds visit your garden!

## WEEKLY ENGLISH TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday – Listen to the story on YouTube. Write a list of the 10 ways we can look after our world.

Tuesday – Choose three different ways you can help your planet. Write a sentence to explain why you need to do each of these using the conjunctions “so” or “because” to explain.

Wednesday – Write a poem about all of the things you love about your world. I'll start you off...  
“I love my world.  
I love the long wavy grass...”

Thursday – Look at some instructions/recipes (you can find some simple ones on the internet). What features do you notice? Can you find the verbs?

Friday – Write a set of instructions explaining how you created your own recycled toy.
