	IMAGINE IT: Imagine you have been sent to live with strangers. How would you feel? What would you tell your new family about yourself?	

## WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday: Research any of the animals in the book and find out their life cycle and food chain	Tuesday: In the book the animals are <i>prejudiced</i> towards the "monster" Find out more about prejudice and how we can avoid it.	Friday: What is evolution? Research how the crocodile has evolved over time? Draw the stages.
	Wednesday: In the book the animals work as a team. Find or design a game to play in teams that would be safe to play socially distanced	
	Thursday: What part of the world is the story set in? What continent is it on? Create a fact file about this region.	

## WEEKLY ENGLISH TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday Thud is an example of onomatopoeia - Words that sound like the sound they describe. Find some other examples and make a sound poem.	Tuesday: Create your own monster. Describe it using expanded noun phrases, similes, metaphors, personification etc.	Friday:
	Wednesday Read the poem Jabberwocky – it uses portmanteau words – nonsense words made by combining two words together. Create some portmanteau words of your own.
