EXPLORE IT: What is happening? Who are the main characters? Write a summary of the text

ILLUSTRATE IT: What impression do we have of Tom Oakley? Draw him from William's viewpoint. Sketch William from Mr Tom's perspective.

TALK ABOUT IT: Look at the front cover of the book.. What do you notice about the body language in the picture?

CREATE IT: Imagine you are going away and can only take 5 items with you. What would you take and why?

IMAGINE IT: Imagine you have been sent to live with strangers. How would you feel? What would you tell your new family about yourself?

### WEEKLY TOPIC TASKS (1 PER DAY)

Monday: Look at how the crocodile has evolved over time. Draw the stages.	Tuesday: Google how to draw a giraffe. Follow the different steps to draw a giraffe.	Friday: Research any of the creatures in the book and find out about their life cycle and food chain.
