- 5:00pm rehearsal ends and children have 1 hour tea break. They will need a packed tea and drinks for the duration of the day. They will have the opportunity to re-fill a water bottle.
- 7:00pm - concert commences
- 9:15pm concert ends and children will leave the arena to return to the coach. This could take some time in order to ensure the safety of all children.
- Children **ARE NOT** permitted to leave the arena and go home with parents. They **MUST** be collected from school at approx. 10:00.

There will be more information about purchasing parents/carers concert tickets, t-shirts and the concert DVD once we have confirmed our seat numbers. T-shirts will cost £12. Tickets will be roughly £15-£20.

Miss Cooper and Mrs Scales have already had a sneaky peak at the music which includes a Queen Medley, "Frightfest" (which includes Monster Mash and Ghostbusters), the R.E.M classic – Shiny Happy People and everyone's favourite....the Pop Medley!
